



**INDIAN HILL  
CHARTER REVIEW UPDATE  
NOVEMBER 27, 2019**

This is an update to the October 30, 2019 Bulletin article regarding the Indian Hill Charter review.

- **September 5, 2019** - A general overview of the charter changes was presented at the Community Forum. The recommended changes include both stylistic (formatting, grammar, categorizing) as well as substantive
- **September 23, 2019** - Council held a first reading on the recommended Charter changes
- **October 21, 2019** - A second reading was held, with a Public Hearing, at the Council meeting. No changes to the recommendations were made.
- **November 18, 2019** - A third reading was held and Council unanimously passed an Emergency Ordinance to submit the Charter recommendations to the Hamilton County Board of Elections to be placed on the March 17, 2020 ballot. No changes to the recommendations were made.
- **December 2019** – Recommended Charter changes sent to Hamilton County Board of Elections, prior to the mandated December 10, 2019 deadline, to be approved as a ballot issue
- **January/February 2020** – letter sent to all residents which includes the recommended Charter changes and an Executive Summary
- **March 17, 2020** - Recommended Charter changes included on election ballot for resident vote
